Partner nations to curb global terrorism

India, besides fuelling the global terrorism transnational crimes through its dirty money. Shah cited an estimate of \$ 400 billion of illicit drug trade happening globally, giving an issue facing humanity.

Home Minister laid emphasis on the need for joint actions to join hands and supplement each other's efforts in fighting this menace, as this global issue cannot be fought by any country individually. He said emphasis that National of the BIMSTEC are specially affected by illicit trade, transnational terrorism, making it more important to devise coordinated

tonnes in 2018. He also said that Manipur and Mizoram having borders with Myanmar and other coastal States are sensitive and may become a gateway for illicit drugs entering India, which needs to be prevented.

Talking about the steps taken by Government of India in combating the drug trafficking, Shah said that the Union Government has laid down a well thought out strategy to increase coordination among the agencies of the Centre as well as States and the Home Ministry has established a joint coordination committee to increase surveillance over drug trafficking.

The Ministry has also started an e-portal for digitalisation of drug data that may be utilized by various drug enforcement agencies.
