

Only those elected will rule in democracy: Mann at LDF protest

Punjab Chief Minister Bhagwant Mann slammed the BJP-led Centre on Thursday for "attacking" federalism and using governors in opposition-ruled states to hinder the governments' work, and stressed that only those who have been elected by people have the right to rule in a democracy.

Speaking at the Left Democratic Front (LDF) protest led by Kerala Chief Minister Pinarayi Vijayan here, Mann said he was forced to come to Jantar Mantar instead of making policies for Punjab. "We should have been in our secretariats, making policies, but we have come here to seek our rights. It is important to stick together to save the country," he said. The Aam Aadmi Party (AAP) leader accused governors in opposition-ruled states of hindering the state governments' work. "The (Punjab) governor said the Assembly session was illegal, so we had to go to the Supreme Court.... The BJP is nowhere in Punjab. It has only two MLAs. Wherever the BJP is not present, the governors act as the opposition," he said. "Those elected will rule in a democracy. You cannot dictate. You cannot keep sitting on a bill," Mann said. He also mentioned a con-



troversy around the Chandigarh mayoral polls held on January 30. The Bharatiya Janata Party (BJP) swept the polls against the Congress-AAP alliance. Manoj Sonkar of the BJP defeated the AAP's Kuldeep Kumar for the mayor's post, polling 16 votes against his rival's 12. Eight votes were declared invalid. Opposition councilors accused the presiding officer of tampering with the ballot papers, a charge denied by the BJP. "You must have seen what happened in Chandigarh. They had to count 36 votes and they did a scam of almost 25 per cent votes.... In May, 90 crore votes are going to be counted," Mann said, referring to the upcoming Lok Sabha polls. DMK leader Tiruchi Siva accused the Tamil Nadu governor of interfering in the work of the state government and said, "We have assembled here to make the country realise that we are

against the authoritarianism of the Union government headed by the BJP." "The states are being suppressed, our rights are being usurped," he added. The DMK leader alleged that governors in opposition-ruled states are indulging in "extra-constitutional, unwarranted activities". "They are not allowing the state governments to make laws. In Tamil Nadu, the governor does the same and everyone knows what the Kerala governor is doing. Have you ever seen a governor sitting on a dhama on a street?" he asked. Siva expressed confidence that the opposition will form the government at the Centre following the Lok Sabha polls that are likely to be held in April-May. "The DMK has two slogans -- state autonomy and abolish governorship. The 2024 election is the only opportunity available to us. Go

to the polling booth with the ballot paper in your hand and when you return, the BJP government would have fallen and our alliance would have assumed power. On the next Independence Day, the prime minister of our alliance will hoist the (national) flag at the Red Fort. That day is not far," he asserted. National Conference (NC) president Farooq Abdullah asked why Assembly polls are not being held in Jammu and Kashmir and wondered what was gained from the abrogation of the provisions of Article 370 of the Constitution. "When they (Centre) abrogated Article 370, they said it was responsible for terrorism. Yesterday, two innocent people were shot dead (in Srinagar)," the former Jammu and Kashmir chief minister said. "You have denied us election, which is our right according to the Constitution. Are we not part of India that you have denied us the basic right to govern ourselves? Give us our constitutional right so that we can move forward," he said. The veteran leader stressed that the opposition is not an enemy of the government. "If you want a strong India, do not consider the opposition as an enemy. The opposition is essential.... Par-

liament is not meant to be one-sided. None of us who sit in Parliament wants India to fail," he said. Former Congress leader and Rajya Sabha MP Kapil Sibal talked about the electoral bonds scheme and alleged that the money earned by the BJP through these is being used to destabilise governments in states ruled by opposition parties. "The BJP has collected around Rs 5,000 crore through electoral bonds. In the Supreme Court, I asked do you use it for elections? Because an MP cannot spend more than Rs 95 lakh in an election and an MLA cannot spend more than Rs 45 lakh.... This fund is used when they have to topple opposition governments," Sibal said. Talking about a case lodged by the Enforcement Directorate (ED) against former Jharkhand chief minister Hemant Soren, he said, "They said there is a benami land. When Soren said it is not his land, they claimed that someone near the property told them so.... They said a woman sitting there said it was the chief minister's land." Sibal also dismissed the BJP's allegation that the opposition is trying to create a north-south divide and accused the ruling party of creating divisions in the name of religion and caste.

Chandigarh Police served notice by HC for stripping slapping jawan

An Army jawan has approached the Punjab and Haryana High Court after he was allegedly stripped and slapped at a police station in Chandigarh when he went there to meet his estranged wife.

The jawan's Commanding Officer wrote to the Chandigarh police chief saying the incident "filled him with rage."

On a petition filed by Naik Arvinder Singh, the high court has issued notices to the Chandigarh Police and others and directed that the CCTV footage of the police station be preserved. It listed the matter for February 21.

Singh's Commanding Officer from 10 Corps Signals Regiment also wrote to the Chandigarh DGP, claiming that the incident caused the serving soldier severe mental trauma.

The incident "filled him with rage" because of the insult it brought upon not only the individual, but the Indian Army as a whole, the CO wrote seeking an inquiry into the incident.

In his petition, Naik Arvinder Singh, who was posted in Bathinda, submitted that he was married to one Manpreet Kaur, who was posted as a constable in the Chandigarh Police. The couple has a 7-year old son and is estranged.

On November 12 last year, the petitioner came to Mohali in Mullanpur Garibdas area to meet his mother. Singh submitted that a sub-inspector from came there and took him to the Mullanpur Garibdas Police Station, where he insulted and threatened him. His wife told him if he wanted to meet his son, then he needed to come to the police station in Sector 11.

According to his complaint, the soldier was threatened with an FIR under the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act and the Arms Act. He said he was forced to sign blank papers and asked to take off his clothes at the behest of the station house officer of the Sector 11 Police Station.

When he protested, he

was beaten up and his turban came off, he said.

He said police also recorded a video of him naked and told him to stay away from his wife and son or else they will upload the video online.

Singh submitted that he had written to the Chandigarh Senior Superintendent of Police to take action in the matter but nothing came out of it.

He was forced to approach his CO, who then wrote to the Chandigarh Director General of Police on January 3.

The CO in his letter wrote that the incident brought out the "apathy, corruption and vagabond" attitude of the state police which claims to have a motto of "We Care For You."

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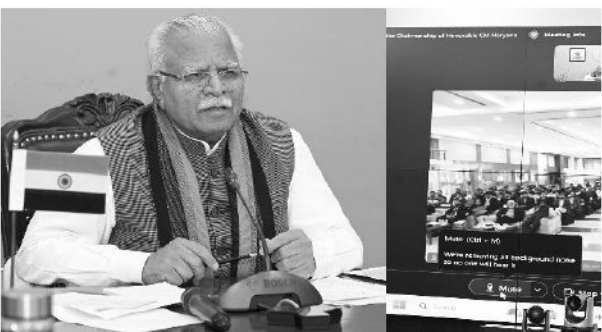
Haryana's PPP is a unique initiative on Global Stage, says Manohar Lal

Strict action is being taken against immigration scammers, says Anil Vij

Haryana Home and Health Minister, Anil Vij said that a total of 1260 immigration scammers (Kabootarbaaj) have been arrested by the Special Investigation Teams (SIT) formed to deal immigration fraud in the state. He mentioned that strict action is being taken against immigration scammers (Kabootarbaaj) in the state, if found in indulging such activities.

Vij redressed the grievances to the people of the state in Ambala today. He emphasized that the SIT formed by them is actively arresting immigration scammers (Kabootarbaaj) to protect the innocent public from their scams.

The Home Minister highlighted the efforts made by the SIT, stating that the previous SIT arrested 664 im-

migration scammers (Kabootarbaaj) in its approximately two-and-a-half to three-year term, while the current SIT has arrested a total of 596 immigration scammers (Kabootarbaaj) in its nine-month tenure. He emphasized that the Cabinet recently approved the Haryana Registration and Regulation of Travel Agents Bill, 2024 to address fraudulent activities related to immigration, especially involving corrupt travel agents from Punjab and Haryana.

In another issue, Vij directed the Police Commissioner of Faridabad to take action in cases related to dowry despite complaints not being addressed. He also instructed the Superintendent of Police (SP) in Sirsa to investigate a case of fraud involving a promise of employment.

Haryana CM suspends Naib Tehsildar & Patwari of Bhiwani

Haryana Chief Minister, Manohar Lal has immediately suspended the Naib Tehsildar, Alamgir and Patwari, Lalit Kumar of Bhiwani on charges of delaying and misreporting facts related to a mutation case. Action was taken against a complaint received on the CM Window under Rule 7.

Giving more information in this regard, Chief Minister's OSD, Bhupeshwar Dayal, stated that Kamala Devi, a resident of Bhiwani district, had filed a complaint on the CM Window regarding the mutation of property in her and her sister's name as per their father's registered will after his demise. Taking cognizance of the complaint, the CM Window headquarters sought a



report from the relevant Naib Tehsildar.

He explained that Naib Tehsildar Alamgir, citing Patwari Lalit Kumar's report, reported to the CM Window that a copy of the mutated property had been given to the complainant, Kamala Devi, whereas in reality, no copy of such was provided to her.

Furthermore, due to the failure to furnish the mu-

tation work within the timeframe set by the Haryana Right to Service Commission, Naib Tehsildar Alamgir was fined Rs. 20,000, and an order was issued to compensate the complainant with Rs. 5,000.

Bhupeshwar Dayal mentioned that upon reviewing the entire process, Naib Tehsildar and Patwari were found guilty of submitting incorrect reports to the CM Window. Therefore, the Chief Minister has ordered the immediate suspension of Naib Tehsildar Alamgir and Patwari Lalit Kumar and directed to take action against them under Rule 7. Additionally, the Chief Secretary and Financial Commissioner, Revenue, were directed to ensure the submission of a report on the action taken within 10 days.
